Spanish Elective Course

Grades 5-8

Cost per student: \$55.00/month (*non-refundable*)

**No payment is due upon enrollment—you will be billed monthly
(September-June)**

These are year-long elective courses. The Spanish teacher, Mrs. Trofimczuk, will help determine student placement in the appropriate class. Spanish 2 & 3 require a pre-requisite course. Students will receive grades for these courses on their report cards. **A minimum of 10 minutes of homework per class day is required for each of these classes.**

Course Objectives:

- Gain mastery and retention of Spanish vocabulary
- Grow in the ability to read, write and speak Spanish

Spanish 1 - Mondays and Wednesdays, 8:00 a.m.-8:50 a.m. (Classes begin August 28th)

Course Description: This is a very important foundational class for the students to learn how to write proper sentences and how to converse in Spanish. Students will be introduced to the present, past and future conjugations, and they will also learn several Spanish songs, The Pledge of Allegiance, numbers 1-20 (30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100), things in the garden, things in the kitchen, transportation, time, weather, seasons, opposites, several important Spanish verbs, ser & estar.

Spanish 2 - Tuesdays and Thursdays, 8:00 a.m.-8:50 a.m. (Classes begin August 29th)

Course Description: This class will build upon the previous course by reviewing numbers 1-10,000, things in the garden, important words, grammar and prepositions, opposites, verbs, ser and estar, and present, past, future tense conjugations. Followed by learning new conversations in Spanish, and an introduction of the book, "Ya Se Leer," where they will continue to learn how to read, translate and speak Spanish. They will also be introduced to the imperfect, conditional, present progressive conjugations, as well as reflexive pronouns, irregular verbs and direct and indirect object pronouns. In addition, the student will be learning the songs, "The Feelings," "Goodbye Friend," "Happy Birthday," "De Colores," and "Cielito Lindo."

Course Description: This class will build upon the foundations of the previous classes by studying the book called, "Prentice Hall: Realidades." With this textbook the students will have access to the interactive textbook, a companion website, and downloadable audio files. Speaking only Spanish during the class will be mandatory.
